

## Call for improvisational musicians of contemporary music

Apply for a week of no-cost improvisation workshops led by teachers from 20 European music universities. Improvisation concerts by students and teachers. Networking with students from other European universities. **Two spots will be awarded!** 

## Time period:

- 1st March 2026, Travel to Lübeck University of Music
- 2–7 Workshops, concerts, lectures
- 7th / 8th March afternoon travel back
- + an online meeting beforehand between November and February, date will be announced Participation is mandatory on all days

**Costs:** Travel and accommodation costs will **be covered by Erasmus+** as follows:

- The time on site (mandatory for all 6 days) with a flat rate of €79.00 per day
- additional 1–2 travel days (definitely one arrival day and, if the return journey takes place on the day after the BIP, also a second return day) also with a flat rate of €79.00 per day
- a travel allowance of €309.00 or an increased travel allowance of €417.00 for climate-friendly travel (and possibly additional travel days if the trip takes longer)
- for students with fewer opportunities criteria available in the Erasmus office a top-up of €100.00 will be made available

Information: The ABPU has joined a European network for improvisation at universities (metric). This means we can send two students who want to specialize in improvisation to the upcoming Intensive Programme (IP).
